“Mr. Lisuzzo has been a member of Ashley Madison since 2008,” Zimmerman says. “He is a single man and he would like to continue to use the website in a [secure](#) fashion.”

So Zimmerman says he’s suing the owners of the website to try to guarantee [security](#) in the future.

The lawsuit also complains about “fake female profiles” it claims the Ashley Madison owners set up.

The parent company of Ashley Madison released a statement: “We are aware of reports concerning lawsuits being filed against Avid Life Media. Avid Life Media Inc. will address any litigation in the appropriate [forum](#), and will not be commenting further.”
